Assignment 3

In this assignment, you will need to create 3 web pages.

1) In the first page you will need to create a list of the topics we have covered in this course. You can use the list of chapters (13 chapters in total) on the course web page as a template to create this list, and it's an ordered list. Then under each list item (chapter) you need to create an unordered list with at least three items – they can be concepts, terms, or elements, which you think are the most important.


Please note that purpose of creating such list is not just to merely finish your assignment, but lead you to start going over the course materials and prepare for the final exam.

2) In the second page you will need to create a table exactly like the one below

The table must use 90% of the width of the web browse window and stay in the middle horizontally. Vertically it must use up the entire height of the browse window. Don't forget the proper alignment of the data either.
